

Harold Schwartz Scholarships for College Music Majors/Minors

SENIORS, here is your chance to apply

Instrumentalists (brass, woodwinds, piano, percussion, strings, etc.) and Singers are eligible!

First Prize up to \$10,000

Eligibility:

1. Must be graduating from a Lake, Marion, or Sumter County high school or academy in spring 2021, with a minimum grade point average of 3.0
2. Must be majoring or minoring in music at the college or university of the student's choice during the next academic year
3. Must be available to audition on **Saturday, April 3, 2021** in The Villages. Applicant will be expected to perform **one** piece of published music
4. Winners **must** perform at an Opera Club meeting at the Laurel Manor Recreation Center in The Villages on the evening of **Thursday, April 22nd, 2021** to claim their awards.

Awards:

Financial awards are: **First prize up to \$10,000, Second prize up to \$8,000, Third prize up to \$6,000, Fourth prize up to \$4,000.** Funds are for tuition, lab fees, or books/sheet music for the next academic year after the award only. Scholarship disbursements will be made in two installments, payable to the college or university of the student's choice.

APPLY EARLY - AUDITION SCHEDULE POSITIONS ARE LIMITED. Applications must be postmarked by **Monday, March 1, 2021.** Applications are available through high school music teachers, guidance counselors, or from the Opera Club of The Villages website: www.operaclubofthevillages.com.
